





LIGHT TO MEDIUM ALES

Blonde Ale

Pale straw to deep gold color. Low to medium hop bitterness, slightly malty — a balanced beer, light bodied and sometimes lager-like.

Light to medium in body with a very pale color, hop bitterness is medium to slightly assertive.

WHEAT ALES

Hefeweizen

The "Hefe" prefix means "with yeast", hence the beer's unfiltered and cloudy appearance. Light hop bitterness, and a moderate level of alcohol. The yeast produces unique phenolic flavors of banana and cloves with a dry and tart edge.

Witbier

Very pale and cloudy in appearance because it is unfiltered and has a high level of wheat. Always spiced, generally with coriander, orange peel and other oddball spices or herbs.

Good balance of malt and hops. Bitterness can range from lightly floral to pungent. Fruitiness can range from none to moderate.

Light amber to tawny in color, medium bodied with a malty character. Mildly fruity with an assertive hop bitterness.

Fruit Beer

Malt flavor is typically hidden with a low hop bitterness to allow the fruit to dominate.
